OTHER MODALITIES OF COLLABORATIVE WORK AND KNOWLEDGE TRANSFER NETWORK (KTN) WEBSITE

BACKGROUND

- At the 18th Meeting of the Executive Committee, the Secretariat was requested to evaluate the possibility of generating additional instances of collaboration for the working groups.
- Mechanisms such as
 - **Communities of practice** that collect experiences that already exist in the region.
 - **Innovation communities** that allow developing issues to be addressed.

Current mechanisms

- The evaluation carried out by the Executive Committee in the months after its 18th Meeting suggests that the modalities of collaboration could be partially or totally covered by the KTN and its “Conectados” section.
- **KTN website**: Offers the possibility of sharing documentation on topics of regional interest.
- **“Conectados RTC”**: Space for virtual talks and videoconferences in thematic areas of regional interest.

Knowledge Transfer Network (KTN) website

Virtual space aimed at strengthening knowledge and cooperation in the field of statistics in Latin America and the Caribbean.

It includes all the production carried out by the Working Groups of the SCA and other organizations of the regional statistical community, such as: documents, events, methodological tools, dissemination resources, and expert talks.

2020-2021 Mechanism proposal

- Hold virtual meetings periodically, in which issues of innovation and / or regional interest are addressed.
 - Meetings via Webex
 - They are available in the KTN for later consultation.
- Coordination in charge of a country, to:
 - Define the topics of the virtual talks and organize your realization of the talks.
 - INE of Chile has offered to assume coordination.
 - The coordination would be rotational, for a proposed term to be defined (for example, one year).
