- Online platform to access and process the information available
- Access to all the responding countries and to the statistical instances of the international organizations in LAC

Regional framework of indicators for monitoring the SDGs in LAC



- Preparation of a "Proposal to move towards a regional framework of indicators for monitoring the Sustainable Development Goals in Latin America and the Caribbean" (LC / CEA.9 / 4) by the Technical Secretariat
- Sending a preliminary version to the member countries of the Coordination Group for comments
- Sending to the statistical instances of the UN agencies in LAC for comments in their capacity as observers of the Coordination Group
- Presentation to the SCA as a working document
- Sending additional supplies for post-SCA review work





Coordination with the ad hoc Working Group of the Montevideo Consensus on Population and Development



- Coordination actions between both Technical Secretariats
- Review of the shared indicators between the global SDG framework and the Montevideo Consensus
- Reception of a proposal of 14 indicators of the Montevideo Consensus to be included as complementary indicators in the proposal for a regional framework of SDG indicators
